- Admission to the examination centre will be on production of Admit Card and Original ID proof only. 1.
- Paste the same photograph on the Admit Card as affixed on Application Form in the space provided and 2. then get the photograph and signatures attested from the Gazetted Officer along with stamp of the Gazetted Officer on the Admit Card. NO ENTRY WILL BE ALLOWED WITHOUT ATTESTATION OF PHOTOGRAPH AND SIGNATURES ON THE ADMIT CARD.
- The candidate must present the Admit Card along with ORIGINAL ID (not photocopy or scanned copy) 3. proof (Adhaar ID or Driving Licence or PAN Card or Voter ID or Passport) to the Staff at the Centre otherwise no entry will be allowed.
- Candidates will show their admit card and ID for verification and briefly remove the mask to show his/her 4. face to the invigilation staff at the entry point to avoid any impersonation. After verification, candidates will be allowed to enter the examination hall.
- Candidate must come with a face mask on and bring small hand sanitizer and transparent drinking 5. water bottle. No candidate will be allowed to enter the Examination Centre without face mask/hand sanitizer/transparent drinking water bottle.
